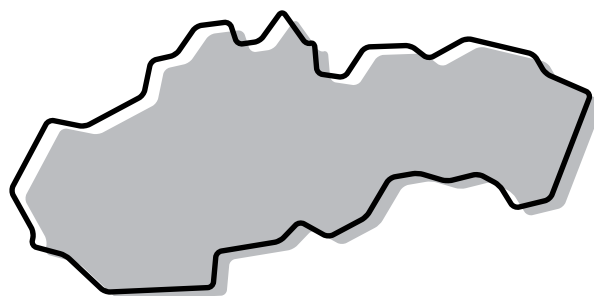


HUMANITARIAN AID OF SLOVAKIA TO UKRAINE

In addition to the material aid that we are sending from the SR, the SR has also been supporting UA via several international humanitarian organizations (UNHCR, OHCHR, WFP, IOM, OSCE, UNICEF, UNESCO, ICRC, UNDP, UN HABITAT, OPCW and more) as well as local non-governmental organizations (e.g. Eleos, New Way, Tandem, Zakarpattia Without Orphans, Berdychiv Charitable Fund Oberig-26, Charitable organization fund of transborder cooperation and special economic zones development, Charity fund St. Nikolai's Clinic) For their activities aimed at helping people in need, the SR has provided financial assistance with a total value of almost EUR 2,52 mil.eur since Feb. 2022.

protection of investigative journalists

Slovakia has also financially supported the protection of investigative journalists in Ukraine via the purchase of material to provide for their safety (bulletproof vests, helmets, emergency housing, first-aid packages) as well as through activities that were made possible as a result of Slovakia's support (for example courses on safety, evacuation).

women and girls

The most vulnerable victims of every military conflict are, in particular, women and girls, who most often face sexual violence. Due to this reason Slovakia, using financial resources from the Mutual Assistance Fund, has financially supported the building of a center for victims of sexual violence in the city of Ivano-Frankivsk in the west of Ukraine.

water and hygiene material

Thanks to Slovakia's financial contributions, supplies of water and hygienic materials are being provided to people who had to be moved to civil protection shelters in Dnipro due to the ongoing war in Ukraine.

energy independence

During the winterization period the MFEA SR provided two financial contributions from the Minister FEA SR for revitalization, reconstruction and support for the energy independence of two facilities in Ukraine with a total value of almost EUR 270 000 in particular for a children's home in the municipality of Serednie (EUR 205,864) and Regional Children's House - children's healthcare institute for orphans and disabled children in the city of Svaliava (EUR 63,350). The contributions from the SR should provide the children's home, when in danger (during bomb attacks), with warm milk and food for more than a hundred children as well as enough to build new premises for dozens of newly received children.
